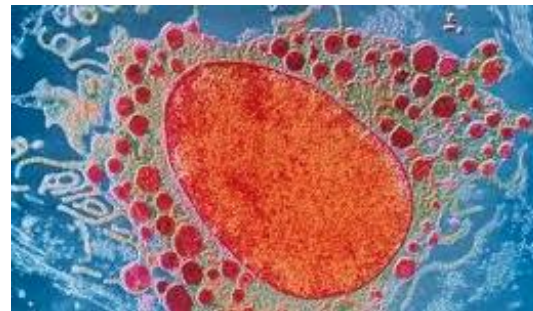

Tips for getting a job

- The basics (I'm sure you've heard it all before)
 - A good CV that has been checked for spelling and readability, and keep it short
 - Follow the application process
 - Network
 - Having an existing connection makes a huge difference
 - I've never got a (paid) job from a 'cold call'
 - Volunteer
 - LinkedIn
 - Keep up with public health affairs – stay relevant
 - Do a good job in your current role!

Tips for getting a job

- The extras (maybe something new)
 - Ask for help
 - Get a diverse skill set (outside of public health skills)
 - Know what you like doing, and what you're good at
 - Don't be afraid to take a leap
 - Take opportunities even if they're not quite what you're looking for
